Raymond Sheppard September 15, 1945 - June 15, 2019


Announcement: Dr. Raymond "Ray" Larry Sheppard (73) died at Vanderbilt University Medical Center surrounded by his lov-

ing family on Saturday, June 15, 2019, after a brief illness.

Obituary: The impactful life of Dr. Raymond "Ray" Sheppard began with his birth to Grace and L.E. Sheppard in New Or-

leans, LA. He attended Louisiana State University (LSU) for both his undergraduate and medical degrees, as well as his Ob/Gyn residency.

Ray moved to Huntsville in 1976 and married Nancy Sime-



precious newborns, often delivering babies of the babies he had delivered. Hundreds of photographs of his patients decorated his office walls. Beyond his surgical prowess, Ray educated and mentored his peers and medical students. To his colleagues, Ray was "a good man to know" because of his high professional standards. To his family and friends, Ray was "the observer" capable of listening intently to multiple conversations, and then, with surgical precision, dropping a side-splitting comment or a nugget of wisdom, before swiftly returning to observation mode! Those quick enough to appreciate his dry wit knew that even a fleeting conversation with Ray could result in

riotous laughter. In contrast to his calm and gentle demeanor, Ray passionately pursued vigorous sports, from flying, running, and biking to scuba diving and golf. He wore many hats at the Huntsville Track Club, and was Race Director of the Huntsville Double-Iron Man Triathlon for several years. A photography nut, Ray and his wife traveled the world to capture amazing images. Among his favorite trips was a photo safari in South Africa and a six-week cruise

through Southeast Asia.

Ray truly loved life and he lived it fully. He was a dedicated LSU Tiger fan and remained true to his roots- enjoying Mardi Gras and Jazz Festivals, Cajun cuisine, and culture. He was a practical jokester, a healer, helper, and friend who impacted social and medical communities near and far.

Ray is survived by his wife of 38 years, Nancy Sheppard, his sons from his first marriage to Linda Yates Brown, Dr. Raymond Sheppard, Jr. (Heather) of Huntsville, AL, and Dr. Adam Sheppard (Niki) of Clovis, CA and daughter Carmella Whitehead (AJ) of Charlotte, NC. He is also survived by twelve grandchildren, brothers Richard, Terry and Mark Sheppard, and his dog, Gumbo.
